# MINUTES

**Present:** Cllrs Stewart Briggs (Chairman), Graham Bates, Irina Madan Sau, Krzys Osuch, Harry Fowler, Peter Chase (Vice Chairman), Chris Gee, Karen Cotton. In attendance: David Brough (Clerk) and four members of the public.

- 1 Apologies for Absence: None. Not present: Cllr Francia Slade (Unwell), Borough Cllrs Roger Rigby (Away) and Jon Gambold (Unwell).
- 2 **Declarations of interest in items on the agenda:** Cllr Bates declared a personal interest in agenda item 10(a) as a member of the social group requesting the commercial oven.
- 3 **To approve the Minutes of the Parish Council meeting** held on 15<sup>th</sup> March 2022. **Resolved** to approve the minutes of the meeting as an accurate record.

# 4 Public Open Session

• One member of the public spoke in relation to the road surface on Bromham Road and the timing of the traffic lights at King George Avenue/Bromham Road.

# 5 **Correspondence (requiring council attention):**

- Parishioner emailed again in relation to the loss of the hedge on Gold Lane and raised an enforcement action with BBC Planning. BBC have requested the tree officer to inspect the hedge and have not yet provided an update.
- Parishioner emailed about the state of the verge on Manor Road. Clerk has advised that this verge is unregistered land, to which the parish council is not legally allowed to take over or maintain (BBC Legal Team advice).
- Parishioner emailed supporting further tree planting in the new season.
- *Request from a parishioner for assistance in locating an area to plant sunflowers.* Clerk to point the parishioner towards Bidwells and the borough council, who are the landowners.
- Parishioner emailed asking to share/coordinate any plans for hosting Ukrainians in Biddenham. Details added to village website.

# 6 Clerk's report on matters in progress

Key actions below – full tracker available on request.

- New trees for Biddenham: BBC have completed planting the 40 new trees for Biddenham, funded by the parish council.
- The new noticeboard for St Mary's is due to be installed the day after this meeting.
- Pavilion EICR electrical testing has been completed and the certification is imminent.
- The pruning works to the trees on Main Road has been completed.

# 7 Reserves policy

The draft Reserves Policy was discussed and debated and amendments were suggested. Clerk will issue a revised version for approval at a future meeting. Councillors will also look to bring spending ideas to council meetings for the spending of CIL money, which will shortly start to be received from development in the parish.

# 8 New defibrillator

To consider a request to provide a defibrillator in the porch at St James' church.

**Resolved** to purchase the defibrillator and box at a cost of £2200, subject to the church taking on future maintenance costs and taking care of any planning implications from the installation.

#### 9 Highways & Open Spaces

- To review an email from BBC Engineering Services about a Social Value Bid for 12 social value projects. Councillors suggested a number of ideas that Cllr Briggs and the Clerk will take forward into a bid.
- To consider extending the annual grass cutting quote to cover an extra 7 cuts on Bromham Road (service road); an increase from 12 to 19 cuts at £60 a cut.
  Resolved to approve this quote.

#### 10 Biddenham Pavilion

To consider a commercial oven for the Pavilion to complement the smaller domestic oven. **Resolved** to purchase a commercial oven at £1300, to cover the electric installation costs, and to accept the offer of £500 from Forum 71 the group who wish to use it.
